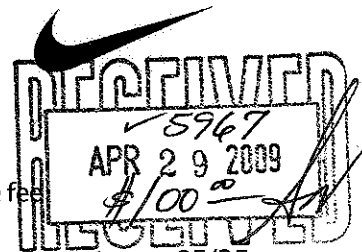

In consideration of permission being granted to Celtic Soccer League to hold a tournament or games at San Bernardino, CA (Hosting Organization) on the dates of March 19-21, 26-28, 2010,

we agree to the following conditions:

1. **ABIDE BY RULES:** We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer *Application to Host A Tournament or Games*, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer *Travel and Tournament Policy* and in this US Youth Soccer *Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement*. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin.
2. **INVITATIONS:** The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed us.
3. **PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE:** We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member, US Youth Soccer and their officers and directors as additional insureds. A copy of the certificate of insurance is attached issued by CYA-South
4. **REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS:** We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical authorizations for each player in a form adequate for use at the site of the tournament or games. These authorizations shall be presented to the Hosting Organization at registration and kept at the field available for use by the team.
5. **ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES:** We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.
6. **CREDENTIALS CHECKS:** We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks (check one)--  
 a.  at registration,  
 b.  at the field prior to each game by a field marshal, or  
 c.  at both sites,  
 to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer *Application to Host a Tournament or Games*.
7. **USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES:** We agree that we shall, in accordance with US Soccer Bylaw 532, use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: All age groups. There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. 8. **USE OF FIELD MARSHALS - FIELD INSPECTION:** We agree that during the tournament or games each game field will have a field marshal assigned to it at all times; that the field marshal will be readily available and identifiable; that prior to the commencement of every game the field marshal will inspect the field to be sure that it is free from objects or conditions that may cause injury. If any condition exists which cannot be immediately corrected, it shall be brought to the attention of the referee and the tournament /games director. The Director of Field Marshals is:




- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

**TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION:** We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.

**POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT:** We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### 1. ELIGIBLE PLAYERS

All teams will be allowed a maximum of eleven loan players with a maximum roster of 18 players. All players will be required to have properly laminated USYSA or league passes and medical release forms. These will be required to be available at the check-in and all matches. Any player without an approved player pass or medical release form will not be allowed to play.

### 2. MATCH TIMES

All matches (preliminary and playoff) will consist of two 30 minutes halves for U14 and U15, two 35-minute halves for U16-U19. Any match may be shortened due to inclement weather.

### 3. MATCHES ENDING IN A TIE

Preliminary round matches ending in a tie, will remain a tie. Quarterfinal, semi-final or championship matches ending in a tie will proceed immediately to FIFA penalty kicks to determine a winner.

### 4. TOURNAMENT SCORING SYSTEM

3 points for a win  
1 point for a tie  
0 points for goals or shutout victory

For 4, and 5 team flights, the top two teams will compete for the championship.

For 6 team flights, the entire flight will be treated as one group and the top two teams will compete for the championship.

For ten team flights we will take the top team from the 4-team bracket, the top two teams from the combined 6-team bracket and then the next best team overall as a wild-card team. Seeding will be similar to a 12 team flight seeding with a wild-card. In bracketing the remaining teams for the 4<sup>th</sup> match, it will be done at the discretion of the tournament committee.

For twelve team brackets, the semi-finals will be comprised of the three bracket winners and a wild-card team. The wild-card team will be the best second place team from the three brackets. Seeding will be best 1<sup>st</sup> place team versus the wild-card team, unless the wild-card team is from the same bracket; in which case the 2<sup>nd</sup> best team will play the wild-card team. In bracketing the remaining teams for the 4<sup>th</sup> match, it will be done by the tournament committee at its discretion.

For 14 team brackets, we will take the best team from the two 4-team brackets and the top two teams from the combined 6-team bracket. Seeding for the semi-final will be the two best teams from the 4-team brackets against the two best teams from the 6-team bracket. Opponents will be determined by the tournament committee at its discretion. The semi-final winners will then play for the championship. In bracketing the remaining teams for the 4<sup>th</sup> match, it will be done at the discretion of the tournament committee.

For 16 team flights, the top team from each bracket will play in the semi-finals, with Bracket A playing Bracket B and Bracket C playing Bracket D. The semi-final winners will play for the championship. In bracketing the remaining teams for the 4<sup>th</sup> match, it will be done at the discretion of the tournament committee.

### 5. STANDINGS TIE BREAKERS

In the event of a tie in the standings after the preliminary round matches, the following method will be used to resolve the tie:

- Head to head competition
- Goals scored
- Goal differential
- Shutout victories
- FIFA penalty kicks

THREE-WAY TIE: Teams ending in a three-way tie, the first tiebreaker will not be the Head-to-head tiebreaker, unless one team has beaten both of its opponents. If one team has not beaten both of its opponents, then the first tiebreaker used will be goals scored. If after any tiebreaker the teams have been split into three distinct positions, then the teams will be in position as indicated. If only

one team has been eliminated, either high or low in position, then the remaining two teams will revert back to head-to-head to determine the remaining two positions.

**6. SUBSTITUTION**

Unlimited substitution will be allowed as follows:

- By either team with any dead ball, for any reason
- Half-time or after a goal is scored by either team
- Injury, if play is stopped, only for injured player
- A player receiving a **YELLOW** card **MAY** be substituted for at that time

**7. DISCIPLINE**

Any player receiving a **RED** card shall be ineligible to participate in the remainder of that match, plus the following match. If a coach is ejected from a match, he will be unable to coach any team in the following match. If the player or coach was ejected for assault then the player or coach shall be ineligible for the remainder for the tournament and their player card will be turned over to the CYSA-South State Association office for disposition.

All matches will have a 5-minute grace period (unless extended by the tournament committee, for reason). Failure of a team to appear on time with at least 7 players will result in a forfeit.

There will be **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** on the tournament grounds. Players, coaches and spectators should display appropriate behavior during the period of the tournament, both on and off of the field of play.

**8. INCLEMENT WEATHER OR UNEXPECTED TERMINATION OF PLAY**

In the event of inclement weather, which the Tournament Committee deems as being unsafe for the players and/or the fields for competition to continue, or the unexpected termination of the match, the following system will be used in determining a winner:

- Matches that are in the second half of play will have the match score stand.
- Matches that are in the first half of play will be deemed not to have been played and both teams will receive a '0-0' score.
- Matches for a given day may be postponed and played the following day, if fields and teams are available.
- Matches may be shortened in order to play all assigned matches.
- If all assigned matches are unable to be played, standings will be based on either FIFA penalty kicks for the top two point teams, or by the Tournament Committee if FIFA kicks cannot be taken.
- NOTE:** If unexpected termination of play is due to the misconduct of one or both teams, then the offending team(s) will not benefit from the termination.

Refunds will be determined as follows:

Cancellation of all matches	100%, less a \$100 administrative fee
One match completed	67%, after a \$100 administrative fee
Two matches completed	33%, after a \$100 administrative fee
Three matches completed	0%

**9. AWARDS**

All participants will receive a tournament pin and program. Trophies or medals will be awarded only to players and coaches competing in Championship or Consolation Championship matches.

**10. HOME TEAMS**

The home team (first listed in the match schedule) shall be on the north or east side of the field and the visitor shall be on the south or west side of the field. Home team must change jersey in the event of a color conflict with the opposing team. If no match ball is supplied by the tournament, then the home team will supply the match ball.

**11. PROTESTS AND FORFEITURES**

**NO PROTESTS CAN OR WILL BE ACCEPTED,  
The FORFEIT-ONE-FORFEIT-ALL rule will be used for  
Preliminary matches, unless the forfeit is due to an  
Administrator not having the proper credentials.**
